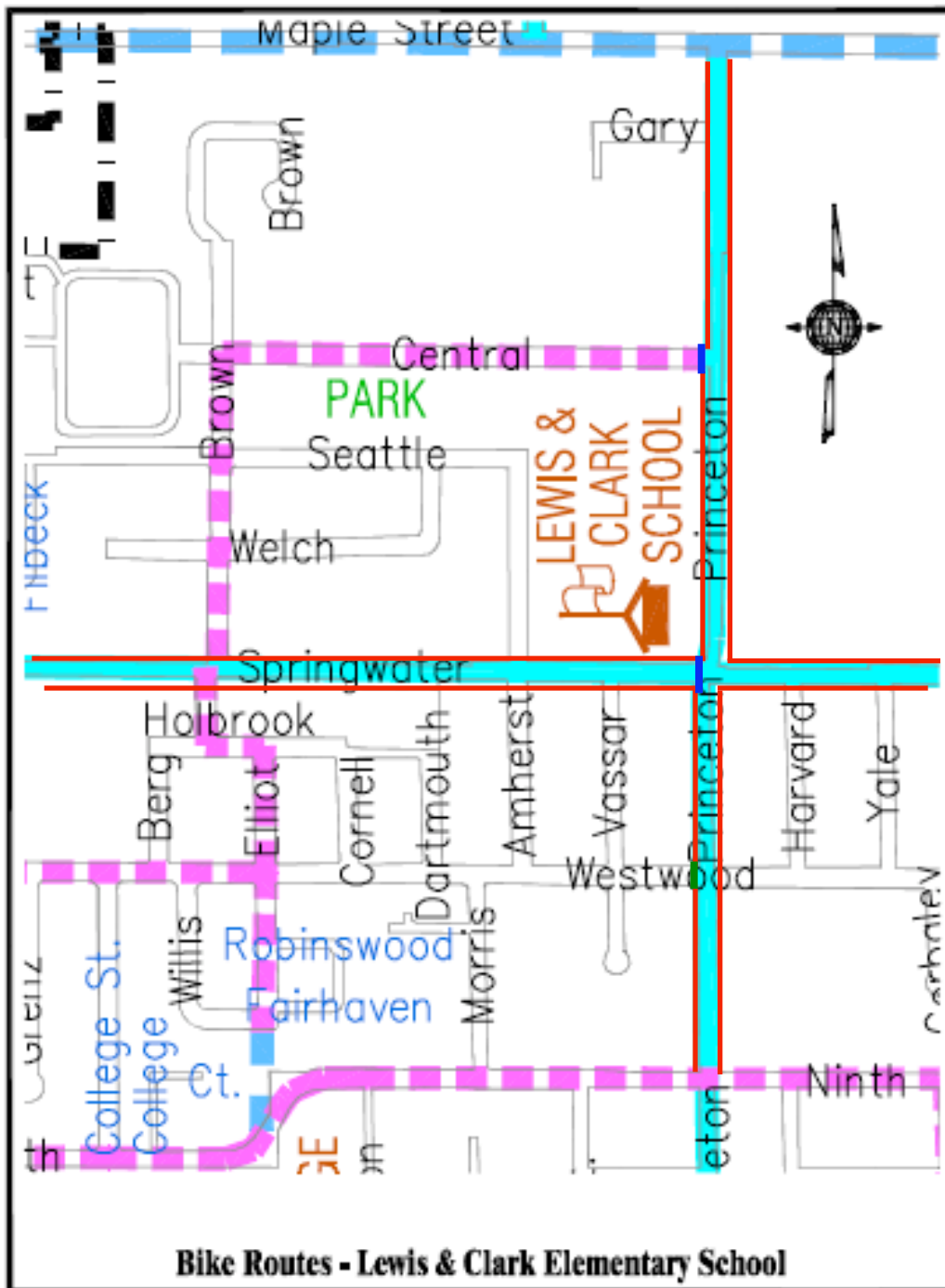













Bike Routes - Lewis & Clark Elementary School

Lewis & Clark Elementary is on the Princeton bike route, so access from either north or south is from Princeton Avenue. The entrance to the school is on the east side, facing Princeton Avenue. The back side of the school can be reached by bicyclists via Brown Street, then east on Seattle Street. Where Seattle Street turns to the south, ride (now on grass) through a small portion of Lewis & Clark Park to reach school property. Springwater Avenue is also a bike route, but on a much busier arterial than Princeton. Elementary-aged children usually ride the sidewalks on Springwater and/or Princeton as an alternative to sharing the roadway with motorized traffic. On school days, students walk their bike when coming or going while on school property. Bike racks are on the front (east) side of the school, near the main entrance.
